Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping at Taitotalo

Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping (OSKARI) helps you to plan your career!

Do you already have work experience, skills or training in a certain profession but aren't sure whether those skills can help you take the next step towards your career here in Finland? Or perhaps you are interested in training for a new profession? We can help you figure it all out!

OSKARI helps you map out your competence and skills and gives you a better understanding of how you can use your skills and develop them further

Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping includes a face-to-face meeting, assignments, and practical tasks.

Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping is carried out over five (5) days for around 5-7 hours per day, between the hours of 8am and 3pm.

A vocational trainer together with a vocational counsellor will conduct and interview and map out your education and work history, general working life skills. You will discuss about the skills, competence and training required here in Finland for your professional field or for the one you are interested in.

You will then take part in different assessments and practical tasks. During your mapping process, you will get a lot of information about different study and work opportunities.

Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping is conducted at Taitotalo (vocational institution) or in a workplace. The Mapping is conducted in either Finnish and / or English.

Certificate of participation

You will receive a certificate after completing your Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping. The certificate is written by a vocational trainer and includes:

- an assessment of your vocational skills and competences
- · an assessment of tasks and assignments carried out
- a proposal for a study or employment plan

The Competence and Vocational Skills Mapping certificate is useful to you when applying for a job and / or study programs.

- cleaning industry
- property services
- construction industry
- business and commerce
- · machinery and technology industry
