The scope of the Vocational Qualification in Logistics

The scope of the Vocational Qualification in Logistics is 180 competence points. The qualification includes vocational units (145 competence points) and common units (35 competence points).

Units:

Compulsory units (100 cp)

- Operating in the work environment of the logistics sector (15 cp)
- Receipt and storage of goods (30 cp)
- Picking and dispatching goods (30 cp)
- Operating material handling equipment and working as a forklift driver (25 cp)

Optional units (45 cp)

The optional units are agreed upon separately with the trainer in the personal competence development plan (PCDP). Optional units include, among others:

- Controlling a drone (5 cp)
- Stocktaking (10 cp)
- Inspecting a pallet rack (10 cp)
- Dispatching goods (20 cp)
- Working in a terminal (25 cp)
- Working in an international work environment (15 cp)
- Workplace instructor training (5 cp)

Common units (35 cp)

- Communication and interaction competence (11 cp)
- Mathematics and science competence (6 cp)
- Citizenship and working life competence (9 cp)
- Optional targeted learning outcomes of common units (9 cp)

Your Skills, Your Timeline

The skills you have acquired in the past will affect the duration of your training. The pathway and duration of a qualification are individual; the average duration is around 2 years. At Taitotalo, you will also have the opportunity for an international exchange during your studies.
